



TRAIN BY BIKE & BUS BY BIKE

Running all year round on the Orléans-Tours-Nantes-Le Croisic line.

Up to **33 bike** spaces all year round (no reservation needed)

Up to **83 bike** spaces from mid-June up to mid-September (no reservation needed)

A special compartment (17 places) for non-standard bikes or trailers from mid-June up to mid-September (booking is free, but we strongly recommend that you book your spot in advance via the Loire à Vélo website)



EUROVELO 6

Loire à Vélo is also the starting point of EuroVélo 6, a European cycle highway running all the way from the Atlantic coast to the Black Sea, a distance of almost 3,600

kilometres. In France, after leaving the Loire at

Cuffy, EV6 continues through the Bourgogne-Franche-Comté and Grand-Est regions, from Nevers to Basel.






For a savoury tooth:


